



### **Safety**

Some non-exhaustive reminders on firearms safety follow below.

#### **Universal Safety Rules**

The universal safety rules for firearms have to be adhered to at any time, no exceptions will be tolerated (see IDPA rulebook chapter 2.1).





#### Cold Range

The match will be held following the cold range rules (see 2.10 2.11). Some important points to remember:

- Transfer of the firearm from the bag to the holster and back can only be done in a safe area
- The firearm carried in the holster has to be unloaded and no magazine inserted
- Manipulation of the firearm can be done only on command of an SO or in the safe area
- Manipulation of ammunition can be done anywhere on the range, except in a safe area

#### **Finger**

Be careful to observe finger safety at all times (see 2.6 and above rule 3). Keep your finger clearly outside and above the trigger guard until ready to shoot. This will make it easy to spot for the SOs and avoids problems!

#### Muzzle

Muzzle over the berm is not permitted on the range, except for revolvers while reloading and with open cylinder.

The 180-rule applies on all stages. Additionally, muzzle safe points and exclusion zones may be defined in the stage briefing (see 2.9).

### **First Aid**

There will be a designated medical team with an ambulance on standby on the range. For minor injuries, all shooters are encouraged to carry a basic first aid kit.

## Registration

Registration is completely done using practiscore. There will be no extra checkin or registration on the range.

Shooters attendance will be checked at the beginning of each stage briefing. Shooters not present will be marked as DNF (Did Not Finish).

#### **Division/Class**

All shooter information will be downloaded to the scoring devices on Wednesday, September 9. Changes made after that date will not be considered.

Please make sure that your division and class are up to date and accurate on practiscore. We will check classification on the IDPA database before the match starts. Be aware that if your registered division/class is not valid on match day, you will not be permitted to participate.

#### **Categories**

Some remarks on the categories (see Match Administration Rules MAR M5.2)

Junior	Age 12-17
Senior	Age 50-64
Distinguished Senior	Age >65
International	Permanently living outside Italy. Even if it's the Swiss Championship.
Industry	Employed in the firearms industry
Military	Serving in the military of his/her country of residence
Law Enforcement	Active law enforcement officer

Please make sure your category (if applicable) is correctly chosen. We will check and correct it before match starts.

### Squadding

Competitors will squad before Wednesday, September 9, on practiscore. From then, no changes will be possible. Shooters that are not squadded on time, will be assigned a squad by the staff.

### **Weapons Permit and Serial Numbers**

We will have to submit a list of participants and their weapons permit (No Porto d'Armi or EU Firearms Passport Number) and firearms serial number to the local authorities.

We added the corresponding fields to the practiscore registration. Please update accordingly using your personal practiscore match registration info page.

## **Match Language**

To accommodate all shooters, we define the match language to be English. Stage briefings will be held in English and explanations will be given in English.

Wherever possible, translations in Italian or other languages will be given.

### **Technical Check**

It is the responsibility of each competitor to make sure that all equipment used for the match is safe, in full working condition, adhering to all applicable IDPA rules and according to applicable Italian law.

#### **Equipment Check**

The SOs will perform an equipment check (holster, mag carrier, belt, concealment) on their stages at a given time.

#### **Firearms and Ammunition Check**

There will be no separate technical firearms and ammunition check stage as it's not mandatory for tier 2 matches. However:

- 1) The MDs will perform random checks on a certain number of shooters. The shooters will be selected by random number using the registration sequence.
- 2) Every SO can perform an equipment check and he/she can request a technical firearm and ammunition check by the MDs at any time without elaborating on reasons.

### **International Shooters**

Please familiarize yourself with the Italian laws concerning temporary import of firearms and ammunition. Shooters from EU/Schengen will need a valid European Firearms Passport and the provided match invitation (see below).

Shooters from other countries please take contact.

#### Caliber 9x19

Please note that caliber 9x19 is NOT allowed in Italy, as also mentioned on the match registration page on practiscore and on the match webpage.

## **Patching and Stage Reset**

Every shooter is expected to help patch the targets and reset the stages as defined in the IDPA code of conduct.

Please make sure that you only patch once the SOs have finished scoring of that particular target.

### **Scoring**

All scoring will be electronic using practiscore. It is the shooters responsibility to check the score after each stage before giving approval. If the shooter is not available for approval of the score, the SO will

approve for him and the score stands. If a shooter wants a personal record, he is encouraged to take (or have an assistant take) a photo of the scoring approval page.

#### **Score Verification**

The score will be published on practiscore immediately after device synchronization after match end. All shooters are encouraged to verify their score online. The verification period ends at the start of the award ceremony.

## **Eating and Drinking**

There will be the possibility to purchase refreshments and foodstuffs on the range. There will be no scheduled breaks so shooters will need to eat and drink on the fly during normal waiting times.

#### **Waste Management**

Please dispose all your waste at the central garbage collection near the restaurant area and ensure proper segregation, thank you.

## Spectators, Children and Pets

Spectators and guests are welcome to attend. Everybody must wear eye and ear protection on the range.

Pets (other than clearly identified service animals) are not allowed on the range.

Children are required to be accompanied by an adult at all times.

### **Stages and Round Count**

The stages are attached at the end of the document.

Minimum round count required for the match is 159 rounds. We suggest to bring some reserve to allow for sufficient ammunition in case of re-shoots and/or ammunition checks.
