MATCH BOOK

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WELCOME TO THE 2018 ITALIAN IDPA NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

The Match Directors and the whole Staff welcome you to the National Championship. Thank you for having chosen to participate in this competition where in three days 290 shooters, Italians and foreigners, will compete in the biggest Italian IDPA match ever!

We will do our best to ensure that this match takes place in the best conditions. In this spirit we have prepared this briefing note containing what we expect to be useful information for the shooters who will compete in the race on Saturday and Sunday.

Minimum rounds necessary for the match: 170 + 7 for the chrono testing, therefore we advise availability of at least 200 rounds.

CHECK-IN

The check-in will take place inside the shooting range, in a location that will be appropriately post-signed. It consists of:

- **Personal data verification;**
- **if applicable, remaining payments due;**
- **gadget lottery and minor awards distribution;**
- **Delivery of t-shirt (Exchange will not be possible in case of inadequate size);**
- **transcription of arm detention/transport licence data;**

Shooters foreseen to shoot on Saturday or Sunday are allowed to check-in on Friday evening from 17.30 to 18.30, but will not be allowed to access the range

The check-in phase will proceed on Saturday morning from 08.00 to 08.45, on Saturday evening from 17.30 to 18.30 and as a last opportunity on Sunday morning from 07.00 to 07.45.

Access to the stages area will be allowed only to the competing shooters, the remaining shooters and visitors will be allowed access limited to the visitors area.

Inspection of the equipment and the chrono test will take place during the match.

The weapons testing shall take place after the check-in but in any case before the start of the match on Friday evening or Saturday evening, and shall take place at the chrono stage close to the lowest entrance of the shooting range as can be seen on the photo. For those shooters that could not do it in time, the weapon control will take place at the chrono stage during the power factor testing.

We shall recall to everybody that the minimum power factor per division is:

**ESP – SSP – CCP F=125 / CDP F=165 / REV with moonclip F=155 with speed loader F=105
BUG F=95**

Shooters arriving on the day before their match are advised to check-in (gadget and shirt collection) and to check the weapons on the previous evening.

If for any reason a shooter has doubts about the regularity of his equipment, he can request its verification before the start of the match during the weapons check phase.
Team or division changes are not allowed.

In addition to the bar-restaurant at the entrance to the Sports Center, we have foreseen a refreshment point directly on the range, where it will be possible to buy food or drink at half-time of the match. However, should the temperatures being high, we advise you to make provision for drinks before the start of the match.

RULES and PROCEDURES

COLD RANGE:

The shooting range falls into the "Cold Range" category, so at no time shall a shooter carry a loaded weapon unless under the supervision and command of a S.O.

Any shooter arriving at the shooting range while legally carrying a loaded weapon shall immediately request the intervention of a S.O. to ensure safe unloading of the weapon before access to the stages.

Handling the weapon is never and nowhere allowed, with the exception of the Safe Areas or within the stages under the supervision of a S.O..

Any violation of the aforementioned rules imply D.Q.

Dropping a weapon inside the stage implies D.Q.. Dropping a weapon outside the stage does not imply D.Q. but requires the intervention of a S.O. in order to secure the weapon.

SECURITY ANGLES:

The upward muzzle limits are given by the lateral and frontal berms.

The horizontal muzzle limit is always the 180° one. Any deviation will be signalled by cones or red flags

RULES OF THE SHOOTING RANGE:

Shooters that are not currently within the competition are not allowed to access the stages. On the day of their competition, shooters will access the stages area through a path that will be marked with colored tape.

The boundaries of each stage will be materialized by a tape, identified by a numbered signboard and by the diagram of the corresponding CoF.

RESTORATION OF THE STAGE:

Setting-up of the stage is the responsibility of every shooter.

In this competition, in order to avoid individual walk-throughs and in order for each shooter to provide the same way to restore the stage, the following procedure will be adopted: “After reading the briefing, the PSO will divide the shooters into several groups, giving each group the responsibility for restoring specific targets (cardboard or steel) and that they shall reach through the shortest route when restoring. As always, the next shooter and the following one are exempted from restoring, all the others must perform their assigned duties. Taking care of unassigned targets if not specifically requested by the SO will be considered as individual walk through and unquestionably a PE will be assigned. Nobody shall leave the group unless previously authorized by the SO. Groups always move together”.

VISITORS AND GUESTS :

Visitors and guests are welcome but will have to respect the rules of the shooting range within the security area and as such must wear acoustic and visual protection. Children and minors have to be escorted by an adult.

RAFFLE PRIZES AND GADGETS

Two raffles will be organized.

At check-in each shooter will participate to the draw of a minor prize or gadget. At the end of the competition and before the award ceremony, a final raffle will be held for those prizes of greater value.

The two raffles are independent each shooter will participate in both of them.

DISPUTES:

We ask the shooters to observe the regulation in case of disputes by contacting first the CSO of the stage and then if necessary refer to the M.D.

Any appeals will be accepted only if lodged in respect of the times and methods provided.

No other procedures or people are legitimate for dispute handling, so we invite you to follow this part of the regulation.

The period of contestation of the scores has a duration of one hour starting from their publishing, which will take place on Saturday evening and at the end of the match.

Consulting the scores can also be done online on the practiscore.com website.

PCC Division:

Rules to be observed:

As per current provisional regulation, the vest is not mandatory in any stage

10 round in magazine (as SSP-ESP divisions);

Start with back towards targets is NOT allowed;

The Cofs report the indications for the start in PCC, and if applicable, the potential points of support of the muzzle as per rules.

The unloaded weapon must always be transported in a bag, with the chamber safety flag inserted

The CoFs are numbered in the same way than the stages: Cofs1 Stage 1, Cofs 2 Stage 2 ecc.....

SHOOTING RANGE ACCESS

For those unfamiliar with the shooting range we would like to mention that the stages of the latter are disposed along an arc (as per picture below).

The stages will be numbered in sequence from 1 to 12, then there will be a stage with a Cof set-up by the Tanfoglio company, and finally the stage dedicated to chrono tests. Beside this, there will be a specific Arsenal stage where it will be possible for the shooters to try their weapons. The Tanfoglio Stage will have its own ranking.
