This Competition Guide contains all the necessary information regarding the **2025 IDPA ITALIAN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP**, which will be organized by ASD Conrad Shooting Club and held at the Conrad shooting range in Casei Gerola (PV).

President Corrado Montagna, Match Directors Pietro Liuzzi and Paolo Fiocchi, together with the entire National Staff, welcome you.

Thank you for choosing to take part in this Tier 4 competition, which over four days will bring together hundreds of Italian and international shooters in the largest Italian IDPA match. We have the pleasure of hosting it at Conrad Shooting Club in Casei Gerola, in the heart of the Oltrepò Pavese wine-producing area—a region rich in history, art, gastronomy, and wine culture.

We will do our best to ensure that the match runs as smoothly as possible.

For this reason, we have prepared this briefing containing a range of useful information for shooters competing on Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.

THE SHOOTING RANGE

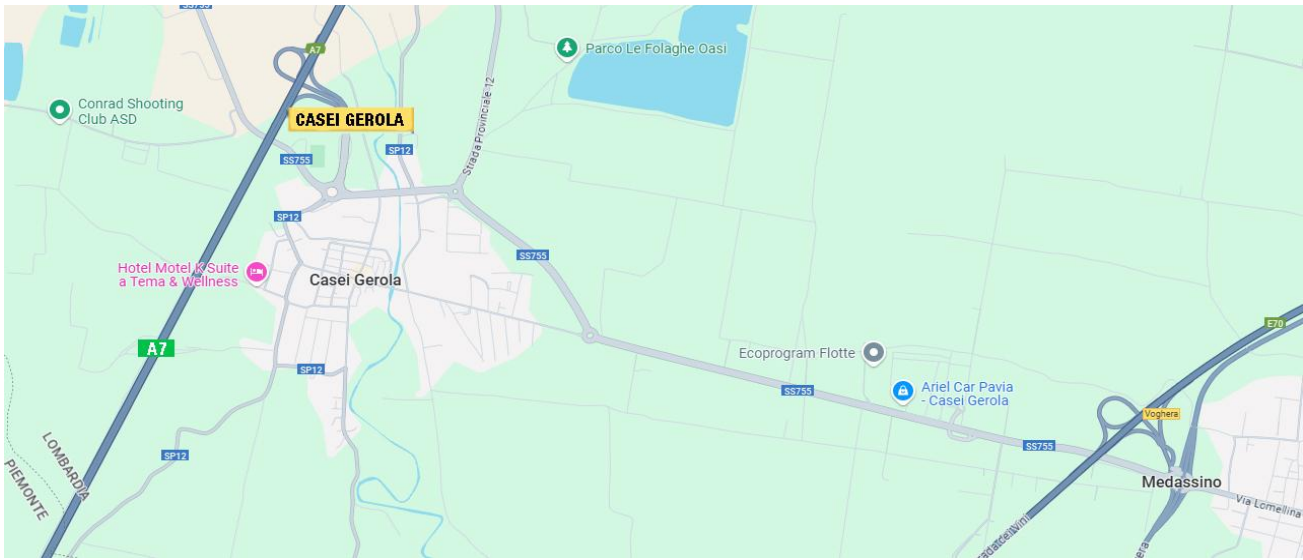

The shooting range is only 2 minutes from the **Casei Gerola** exit on the **A7 highway (Milan – Genoa)** and 6 minutes from the **Voghera** exit on the **A21 (Turin – Piacenza)**.



THE SPORTING COMPETITION

The **2025 IDPA ITALIAN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP** is a Tier 4 match consisting of:

- **15 STAGES:** 13 scenario stages, 1 standard stage, 1 chrono stage, plus a Warm-up exercise (the Warm-up will count toward the score and will be shot by all competitors at the start of each stage).
- **Minimum required rounds: 198 + chrono.**
- A complete **equipment check** is required, including firearm weight and dimensions verification, as well as holster, magazine pouch, and vest legality checks.
 - The **check of holsters and vest** will be conducted at the **first stage**; **firearm check** will be done at the **chrono stage**.
 - Non-compliance will result in DNF (Did Not Finish) from the Match.
- Competitors must be classified in the Division in which they participate.
- In order to be admitted to the match, you must have a valid IDPA membership and classification.

Important info for the validity of Classifiers:

Note: The National is a Tier 4 match, and according to the "2025 Match Administration Rules," the rule on accepted classifications states:

- *M-3.4.15 Shooters must have been classified in the division in which they compete, and that classification must be valid on the day they shoot the match.*
- This means EQUITY classifications are **not valid**; they are valid only for Tier 1-2-3 matches.

IDPA - ASI MEMBERSHIP

To be admitted to the match, you must have valid IDPA and ASI memberships. Shooters who are not ASI members may request annual membership by completing the form downloaded from Practiscore and sending it to: iscrizioninational@conradshootingclub.it

(The **membership will be free**, offered by CONRAD ASD.)

REGISTRATIONS:

Registrations to the match will have 3 different priority levels:

- 1. TEAM – April 5 (teams from a minimum of 5 to a maximum of 10 shooters)**
- 2. MASTER and INTERNATIONAL – April 12**
- 3. ALL SHOOTERS – April 19**

TEAM REGISTRATION (for Friday and Saturday)

From April 5 (8:00 PM) to April 12, 2025 (10:00 AM).

- Teams must consist of at least 5 shooters and at most 10, and must have **one single contact person** for team communications.
- They will have at their disposal:
 - **10 squads on Friday**
 - **8 squads on Saturday**

Team registration, for organizational purposes, must be done **by sending an email to iscrizioninational@conradshootingclub.it**

containing:

- TEAM NAME
- CHOSEN DAY (FRIDAY or SATURDAY)
- FULL NAMES
- IDPA MEMBERSHIP NUMBERS

Squad availability will be allocated according to the **email timestamp**.

The **team contact person** will receive an email with the **registration codes** to be forwarded to the individual shooters so they can **complete** their registration on Practiscore **by no later than April 12**.

Once you receive the confirmation email with the codes, each shooter must pay the registration fee via **bank transfer on the same day they register**. If the club does not receive the bank transfer, the spot may be reassigned at the club's discretion.

REGISTRATION FOR SHOOTERS WITH MASTER CLASS AND INTERNATIONAL SHOOTERS OF ANY CLASS

From April 12 (8:00 PM) to April 19, 2025 (10:00 AM).

These shooters will be able to register for any day and any available slot (**with a registration code**). **Master** and **International** shooters must register, for organizational purposes, by sending an email to iscrizioninational@conradshootingclub.it containing:

- FULL NAME
- NATIONALITY
- IDPA MEMBERSHIP NUMBER
- CLASS
- DIVISION
- DAY (Friday or Saturday or Sunday)
- Preferred Squad Number (if any)

The shooter will promptly receive an email with the **registration code to use** on Practiscore **no later than April 19**.

The registration fee is €130.00, payable **by bank transfer on the same day as registration**. If the club does not receive the bank transfer, the spot may be reassigned at the club's discretion.

OPEN REGISTRATIONS FOR ALL SHOOTERS

From April 19 (8:00 PM) to May 30 (8:00 PM).

Open registrations for categories from NV to D.M.

The registration fee is €130.00, payable by **bank transfer on the same day as registration**. If the club does not receive the bank transfer, the spot may be reassigned at the club's discretion.

CHECK-IN

Check-in will take place inside the facility in a CHECK-IN area, indicated by appropriate signage.

- Verification of registration data
- Collection of the Shooter Badge (to be displayed for match access)
- Collection of the Welcome Bag
-
- **Friday Competitors** can check in on **Thursday** evening from 6:00 PM to 7:00 PM, but are not authorized to access the shooting bays.

Saturday and Sunday Competitors can check in on **Friday** evening from 5:30 PM to 6:30 PM, but are not authorized to access the shooting bays.

Check-in will continue:

- Saturday morning from 8:00 AM to 8:45 AM
- Saturday afternoon from 5:30 PM to 6:30 PM

- Sunday morning from 7:00 AM to 7:45 AM

Access to the stage area will be allowed **only** to shooters who are competing. Remaining shooters and accompanying persons may access but must remain in the visitors' area.

Holsters and gear inspection will take place on the **first stage**, while **gun and chrono** checks will be conducted during the match at the **chrono stage**.

RANGE SAFETY RULES

The shooting range adheres to the IDPA "Cold Range" policy.

- All shooters must comply with current Italian laws on firearm and ammunition transport and use. The organization assumes no responsibility for non-compliance.
- Access inside the bays is permitted only during the shooter's assigned time slot; otherwise, visitors must stay in the designated visitor area.
- The shooting range parking area is not supervised.
- Everyone who enters the range must wear eye and ear protection.
- The organization is not responsible for any damage caused by negligence or failure to respect the listed safety rules.
- Firearms may only be handled in the "SAFE AREAS" and within the bays under the direct supervision of a match official (MD, CSO, or SO). Handling a firearm outside of these circumstances will result in disqualification from the match.

- Unless otherwise specified in the stage description, the 180° safety plane will be used horizontally, and the top of the lateral berms will be used for muzzle elevation.
 - Exception for revolver reloads with the cylinder open and the finger visibly outside the trigger guard. With the cylinder closed, the muzzle must remain within indicated safety limits; failing to do so will incur a DQ.
- The AIWB (Appendix Inside Waist Band carry) holster is NOT ALLOWED (M.A.R. Rules M-1.6.7).

PCC TRANSPORT

- The firearm may be transported in a case and may only be removed at the firing line under the supervision of a Safety Officer, even without a flag, keeping the muzzle pointed downrange. It must be re-cased after the end-of-course commands.
- Alternatively, it may be transported “muzzle up” with a flag inserted and placed on the rack located outside each bay.
- Sling carry is NOT permitted.
- Personal carts are allowed, provided the weapon is secured in an upright position with the flag inserted.
- Firearms out of the case and without a flag will result in immediate disqualification (DQ) from the match.

AMMUNITION

- Ammunition is the responsibility of the competitor.
- Any type of projectile is allowed.
- Ammunition cannot be purchased at the range.

BRASS PICK-UP

- To avoid delays during the event, shooters may NOT pick up brass from the ground.
- However, at the end of the shooting day, at the discretion of the Safety Officer present on the stage, it may be allowed.

MATCH RULES

The **2025 IDPA ITALIAN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP** is a Tier 4 match and will be managed according to the current IDPA Rulebook and Match Administration Guide.

It is the shooters' responsibility to know and follow the rules throughout the match.

SCORING

- Competitor scores will be managed electronically using the Practiscore platform.
- At the end of each Course of Fire (CoF), the SKSO (Score Keeper Safety Officer) will show the shooter the tablet screen with the assigned score and will verbally ask the shooter to approve the score by pressing the APPROVE button.
- It is the shooter's responsibility to approve on the tablet and verify the correctness of the recorded score.

AWARDS

- Awarding of Subcategories¹² with a minimum of 3 participants (M.A.R. M-5.1).
- Prizes will be allocated based on the number of participants in each Class and Division, awarded to the top fifth of them.

For example:

- 1–5 shooters in ESP/MM = Prize for 1st place
- 6–10 shooters in ESP/MM = Prize for 1st and 2nd
- 11–15 shooters in ESP/MM = Prize for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd
- 16–20 shooters in ESP/MM = Prize for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th, etc.

SQUAD MANAGEMENT AND STAGE RESET

It is crucial that all shooters participate in stage reset. The only exceptions are:

- The shooter who has just finished the CoF
- The shooter who is next on the line
- The shooter “on deck” (after the next)

After the command “Range is Clear,” shooters follow the PSO for scoring, taping, and resetting the targets one by one as the score is recorded on the tablet. Targets should be taped only after the Safety Officer has scored them.

STAGE BRIEFING

Before each exercise, there will be a group walkthrough where the Safety Officers will:

- Read the stage briefing
- Identify points of cover
- Identify visual barriers
- Provide all necessary information for shooting the stage
- All shooters move together through the stage only once during this briefing.
- It is not allowed to practice the shooting positions after the walkthrough, nor to perform air gunning inside the stage area. Violators will receive a procedural penalty.

COURTESY

Please be polite to Match Officials and staff members. They are responsible for maintaining safety and running the stages. Follow their instructions.

Match Officials are volunteers who dedicate their free time to make these sporting events possible.

If you have a complaint or disagree with a call or decision made by a Safety Officer (SO) or Score Keeper Safety Officer (SKSO):

- Ask to speak with the Chief Safety Officer (CSO)
- Or, as a last resort, speak with the Match Director (MD)

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

An ambulance service (with driver-paramedic plus an additional paramedic) will be on-site.

FOOD AND REFRESHMENTS

Vending machines with hot/cold drinks and snacks are available.

There will be a catering service offering meals, hot sandwiches, and beverages for all shooters.

The Staff will have a catering/restaurant service during all match days.

GALA DINNER AND PRIZE DRAW

On **Saturday at 8:30 PM**, there will be a Gala Dinner with all Staff and shooters at the restaurant of **PARK HOTEL** (Via Diviani, 8 – Salice Terme, PV). You'll have the opportunity to taste DOC wines typical of the **OLTREPÒ PAVESE**, with a menu consisting of:

- Appetizer
- First course
- Main course with side dish
- Fruit
- Dessert
- Wine and coffee

Cost: **€40.00** for shooters who want to book.

During the Gala Dinner with Staff and Shooters, there will be a **random prize drawing**.
